OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Framework to be followed by all Ministries/Departments for bringing all schemes involving components of cash transfers to individual beneficiaries on DBT platform - reg.

The undersigned is directed to refer to DBT Mission's O.M. of even number dated 13.02.2015, 19.02.2015 and 26.02.2015 on the subject mentioned above and to say that DBT Mission prescribed framework to be implemented by all Ministries/Departments for all schemes (Central Sector Schemes and Centrally Sponsored Schemes) where component of transfer of cash benefits to beneficiaries is involved.

The matter of transfer of funds under Centrally Sponsored Schemes was re-examined and decided as under: -

In cases where sanction is made through State Government under Centrally Sponsored Scheme, with or without matching grant by States, the DBT initiative is to transfer funds electronically through Public Financial Management System (PFMS) platform to the respective state Government and ensure that state Government releases funds directly to the beneficiaries electronically.
