OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: On-boarding of scholarship schemes on National e-Scholarship Portal (NeSP) – reg.

Government has started Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) with the aim to ensure accurate targeting of the beneficiaries, de-duplication and reduction of fraud. Most importantly, it is expected to re-engineer the existing delivery process of government schemes for simpler and faster flow of information and funds. The preferred route of flow of funds would involve transfer of defined benefits directly from the concerned Ministries to the bank account of the beneficiary by using the Public Financial Management System (PFMS) platform.

For DBT in scholarships, National e-Scholarships Portal (NeSP) has been developed by Centre for Good Governance (CGG)/Department of Electronics & Information Technology (DeitY) as one stop solution through which all the scholarships of all Central Ministries/Departments will be processed electronically starting from student application, application receipt, uploading of the documents, processing, verification of documents and eligibility, sanction and disbursement including financial and administrative approvals. The whole end to end process is IT based automated and electronic.

It is requested that the details of scholarship schemes alongwith number of beneficiaries and budget allocation, administered in the Ministry/Department may be intimated to the DBT Mission as per proforma enclosed.
